The RKK welding courses comprise three major levels where each builds on the previous level. They fully comply with International Welder standards (IW) (Corresponding IW codes given in brackets):

- Level 1: A1-T1-L1-C1 Welder introduction courses (IW Mod A, B, C and Weld 1210 oxyfuel systems)
- Level 2: A1-T1-L2-C1 Welder adv. course 1 MMA (111) Welding
- Level 2: A1-T1-L2-C2 Welder adv. course 2 MIG/MAG (136) welding
- Level 2: A1-T1-L2-C3 Welder adv. course 3 TIG (141) welding
- Level 2: A1-T1-L2-C4 Welder adv. course 4 Gas (311) welding
- Level 3: A1-T1-L3-C1 Expert course 1 Stainless steel (PSS)
- Level 3: A1-T1-L3-C1 Expert course 2 Aluminium (PAL)

Curricula and content
